



**Quarterly 10-10 Net Report:-** A most congenial group attended the Jan. 25, 1976 quarterly meeting for the installation of officers. The minutes of the Nov. 2, 1975 meeting for the election of officers were read by W6MXT and accepted. W6ENC presented a comprehensive report on the activities of our Chapter Heads and WA6MOF advised us of our financial status. W6LRY covered the operations of our first resident DX Manager ZL1ARO and each of our 10 U.S. District Managers.

WB6YII provided a history of the 10-10 Net and expressed his views on the actions to be initiated to assure the continuing success of the 10-10 Net, essentially as follows:-the 10-10 Net is the largest of its kind and as an international organization we should draw on many of our exceptionally qualified members outside the Los Angeles area to serve as officers in the Net (with the exception of Sec. Treas. who must be a resident of Calif.). Election of officers should be by mail ballot, quarterly meetings should be held outside the So. Calif. area-in other U.S. call areas and DX. A questionnaire should be provided to let our members express their views on matters of concern.

I am acutely aware and share WB6YII's concern for the future success of the 10-10 Net. We have only begun to decentralize our organization with the appointment of resident U.S. District Managers and our 1st DX Manager, ZL1ARO and our Contest Manager K5MRU and Awards Manager W4JO. With the recent appointment of WA6YINQ as the Editor of our new 10-X Chapter News, we may proceed with a plan whereby all our active Chapter Heads and their members participate in the nomination and election of officers. At the next quarterly meeting, I will propose that the Chapter Heads be appointed as the nominating/election committee for the officers of 1977. To implement this plan, a revision to the by-laws will be needed to permit the conduct of net business outside the So. Calif. area. A questionnaire is provided in this issue and we hope that our members will express their views on these matters and forward them to our Editor for compilation (for convenience you may send them to your resident manager with your renewals).

ZL1ARO is most enthusiastic in serving as our first resident DX Manager-a second resident DX Manager may be appointed soon! 7. W6ENC reports a steady growth in new Chapter Head appointments. 8. The Awards Program under W4JO's expert direction is stirring up lots of activity on 10m in spite of low solar flux. 9. WA6MOF alternate NCS of the So. Cal. Chapter reports better than 75% participation in the Sat. 10A.M. PST roll call. About 100 local members also participated in the Feb. 10-X Contest. 10. Postage is our major expense-to defray the initial cost of computerization, we regret to go bulk rate for domestic mailing, but the time we save should more than offset

Prospective Members: On 10 meters, contact 10 present members (DX-5), logging Date, Time, Call, Ten-Ten number, Handle, City, State(DX-country). Send this list to your District or DX Manager along with \$2 for dues and \$1 for a Roster. You will receive a Certificate and will be assigned a Ten-Ten number that belongs to you personally for life.

How To Operate 10-10, Exchange Numbers and Get Awards: First become a member and use your Roster. Log all 10-10 contacts as noted above. Circle the Call in your Roster. This will avoid duplicates. Keep a running account of the total 10-10 numbers at the top of each log sheet. When you have a total of 100 (including the first 10 allowed for membership) immediately apply for your first Bar Award. You should check mark the 10-10 numbers in your complete roster to avoid repeat reporting. We allow the 10 initial contacts but all others counted shall be bona-fide NUMBER EXCHANGES as in a "full friendship handshake." List all information as required for membership (do not send log books). Send your list to our Awards Manager Frank Orcutt W4JO 2752 S.W. 3rd St Miami, Fla 33135. Identify your call and 10-10 number, and state the Bar you are requesting each time. There are Bars for each 100. There are special Plaques for 1000, 2500, and 5000. QSL cards are only required for WAS 10-10. IMPORTANT: Send in each 100 immediately (no extras and never less than 100). Forget about those early uncounted "one-way" contacts as our Awards are for Bona Fide Number Exchanges; one point only allowed for each number exchanged.

Ten-Ten Chapters: More than 100 Nets throughout the World are now in operation and have weekly on-the-air meetings. Many Chapter Nets issue unique certificates which you may earn by participation in their activities. Many of these have serial numbers and are self propogating, so that you can start your own activities. If you wish to organize a local chapter, please drop a line to our Net Coordinator George Elliott W6ENC.

Renewals: To renew your membership, send \$2 with your old Membership Card to your U.S. District or DX Manager. We must have your call letters, 10-10 Number and date of expiration. If your dues are more than six months in arrears you can be reinstated for the \$1 fee (for a Roster in return). Add \$2 (total \$3) for a full years dues. Your District or DX Manager has Rosters available (\$1) and 10-X Stamps (100 for \$1) so state what any extra money is for. Make all checks payable to: "10-10 Net, Inc."

## Chapter Head Activities Report

The following is taken from the reports received from the various Chapter Heads that were received during the last quarter. The complete reports are not in the article only parts and some remarks by the writer.

The Maryland DC Chapter has issued over 1000 certificates. The Chapter has three different certificatea available. Jim Hart WA3NCQ is the Chapter Head and certificate mgr. The Rio Grande Chapter report was from our V.P. Grace K5MRU. Grace and the OM tried to stir up some additional interest by having open house at their home but not many attended. Grace says "not much to report and most not for publication!"

The L-I-A-R-S Chapter in New York sent in a very fine report. The Chapter has 65 members up from 25 a year ago. The Average check ins average 20. The Chapter has dinner meetings to talk over the various programs. There were 64 entries in the contest last year. The Chapter has an on the air discussions of projects that have been published in the news letter that is mailed out to the members. Rich Levy WB2MAN is the Chapter Head and district #2 manager.

The Cypress Chapter in Florida is just getting started but average 6 check-ins per week. The Chapter just elected officers and all are VP-500 members. K4HTU Bob Lucas is the Chapter Head.

The North Georgia Chapter which is one of the newer Chapters has 50 ground wave members and 24 skip members. The Chapter has an award and the call-up is 6:30 PM on Sunday. Chaz Cone W4GKF is Chapter Head.

The Gateway Chapter in Missouri had an average of 23 members that check in at each call-up. The Chapter has a sea faring member that checks in from the wide open sea. The Chapter operated on straight key night. Jim W0QHY is Chapter Head and Bob W0GGO is the secrtrary.

The North New Jersey Chapter sent a very disheartening report due to very little activity and poor conditions. The Chapter operates with the three Minute Net on 29.95 MHz from 7:00 PM to 9:00 PM each Monday. Joe WA2ZDA is the Chapter Head.

The new Chapter in Colorado sent a very disheartening report and a very critical one for several reasons. #1-no mention of the "Ten Ten Centennial Net" in the bulletin, #2-no mention of the 4 awards that the Chapter has available and #3-the Centennial award is self propagating all over the USA #4-Five months to publish a three months bulletin. I am sure that there will be a mention of the Chapter in a future bulletin. The Sky Blue Waters Net in Minnesota sent in the usual fine report. The Chapter has a very active CW net with an average of 27 check-ins per month. The Chapter enrolled 58 new members during the year. Bruce W0GUM is the Chapter Head.

The Milwaukee Chapter is averaging 15 check-ins per week with several visitors. Joe W9TSG Chapter Head says the visitors soon become members. Joe became a member in 1968 and has #310. The Chapter had a QSO party in December and is planning another soon. The SunCoast Chapter in Largo Florida has 2 awards one for 5 members and one for 50. Clint Paine K4EKX is awards manager and district #4 manager, Roy K4FRG is the Chapter Head.

The Chief Seattle Chapter is growing rapidly and has awards available. Carl W7HUL the Chapter Head reports that the Chapter is on the air twice daily and on CW twice weekly but not much activity on CW.

The All American City Chapter in Birmingham, Alabama has an award and issues a bulletin that is received in place of a formal report. Ron Forbis WB4ASV the Chapter Head reports 37 members in the Birmingham area and 142 associate members in 30 states and foreign countries.

The Thunderbird Chapter in Phoenix does not have much to report but average 18 check-ins per call-up and have issued over 300 certificates in 38 states and 5 foreign countries. Ed. WA7DCO is Chapter Head and district #7 manager.

The new Devils Triangle Chapter in Florida is just getting off the ground. The Chapter has a certificate available. Harold W4NNO Chapter Head says we will hear more from the Chapter later.

The Minute Man Chapter in Mass. reported some openings to So. America and Africa. Warren W1FFT Chapter Head is having a hard time trying to convince others to join the Ten-X net with bad band conditions. "Ten members supporting 100 on Welfare"

The Central Tennessee Chapter with J.D. Weatherly WB4PPY Chapter Head hopes that 1976 will be a better year for ten meters. JD is keeping Tennessee on the map. The Indiana Chapter in Bedford Ind. is going strong. Ken Kern K9BEH is Chapter Head and District 9 manager. Ken is busy keeping books and running the Chapter. The Stark County Mutual Aid Net in Ohio is one of the larger Chapters and have a lot of non-member check-ins. The Chapter usually averages about 40 members and non members each roll call. Wm. (Bill) Parks K8JZN is Chapter Head. Bill says that the only place there is an increase in the use of radio is on the CB band. There are a lot of members that have gone on 2 meters.

The new Chapter in Houston Texas have had "eye-ball" meetings and are growing. The Chapter meets Tuesdays and monitors the frequency at all times during the week. WB5FII Bob is the Chapter Head.

The "Green Country Chapter" in Oklahoma is going strong in spite of bad band conditions and Bud W5NNL Chapter Head says the certificate is non propagating so we will have to contact the Okie? Boys to get one. There are plans for a CW net with WB5GZF doing the finger talking.

There was a new Chapter formed in Illinois and chose the name "SIONILLI" Elmer W9ATF is the Chapter Head. We have not received much information on the Chapter to date. The West Coast Chapters are going strong. Dick W6ANKs report looks like "who's who" of radio. Dick is also NCS on Monday's and Wednesday's. The Bay Area Chapter is a live gang. WB6POQ in the Sacramento area heads the Golden Bear Chapter Kay keeps the State Capitol in view. Geo. W6IWU in Kemet is having a hard time getting members to check in but if the band improves he will be busy.

The Michigan Robin Chapter is very active and has as many as 35 members checking in on roll call nights. The Chapter has an award. The Chapter stresses the informal type roll call and everyone gets on the round table. Ed. WA8WEX is the Chapter Head.

The Ten Tuners in the Cincinnati area are involved in the weather watch program and have reported storms before the weather bureau knew of them. Del WB8EDG is the Chapter Head. The Chapter has a certificate. The Ten Tuners were at the top in the last contest. The Southern New England or Nutmeg Chapter in Connecticut is doing well and hold forth on Tuesdays and Sundays. The Chapter has a certificate. Fred Burleigh WA1HMC with Ron K1KYC are Chapter Head and #2 Chapter Head.

There is a group of YLs in Knox County Tennessee that is affiliated with the Great Smokey Mountain Chapter. The YLs are all in the Knoxville area. The purpose of the net is to encourage YLs to get on ten meters and assist the OMs (us) in keeping the band active.
