




MESSAGE FROM THE PRESIDENT 10-10 INTERNATIONAL NET, INC.

August 8, 1976: The 10-10 Summer QSO Party is going great and I'm caught up in the excitement preparing this message for publication. The band openings are fabulous with most contacts centered around 28.6+.05mhz. Grace K5MRU our Contest Manager expresses concern (via WA6MOF) that we are not spreading out. Let's activate our full allocation 28 to 29.7mhz and demonstrate to the FCC that we deserve to keep it all.

The activity of the Colorado Ten-Ten Chapter at the ARRL National Convention in Denver July 16-18, 1976 was a sensational success! The attendance at the 10-X Forum was the largest gathering of members yet for the 10-10 Net. It was indeed an honor to share the podium with Grace K5MRU, Rollie WØLST, Chuck WAØYNQ, and Rich WBØFQD Chapter Head, who conducted the proceedings in a most professional manner. I would like to encourage the Chapter Heads to follow his fine example with full support from HQ. Bert W6CL #17762 deserves a special commendation for creating the handsome Colorado Ten-Ten Chapter banner displayed prominently in the 10-X booth. It certainly attracted favorable attention from all the conventioneers. It was a very memorable occasion especially for me when NOØARL QSY'd to 28.8mhz at 1800Z Sat. July 17th to participate in the roll call of the So. Calif. Chapter with Joe K6CQN as net control and Mary WA6MOF as alternate. Again my sincere thanks to Rich WBØFQD and to the members of the Colorado Ten-Ten Chapter whose diligent effort and sincere hospitality contributed so much to the success of this most significant event in the history of the 10-10 Net.

The bicentennial issue of the 10-X Chapter News is reprinted as a special tribute to the Editor Chuck WAØYNQ. The first page of the June, July, Aug. Newsletters of the International 500 is also reprinted as a special tribute to the Editor, Frank W4JO. Frank also serves as our Awards Manager. The officers of the net have initiated a HUMANITARIAN AWARD, and the president is inviting Chapter Heads and members to submit to him any such recommendations. He will then present them for approval at the meetings. 

Message from the President (continued from page 1):

Please keep this special souvenir Bulletin as a ready reference for 10-10 Net information. The roster supplement attached now replaces those in previous issues and brings the May 1975 Roster (listing 10,000 members+) up to date. We plan to publish a complete new edition of the roster by Jan. 1977, when the inventory of May 1975 Rosters should be low. To avoid annoying delays, please note the QTH of your DX or U.S. District (call area) Manager for renewals and pass the correct QTH on to prospective members. This Bulletin will be mailed to members on our mailing list with an expiration date of Jan. 1, 1976 or later. Should we achieve our goal of a Bulletin each quarter, then the bylaws will be invoked. "Members in arrears of dues in excess of three months shall be dropped from the mailing list." As a reminder, your expiration date will be imprinted on the mailing label (e.g. 0577=May 31, 77).

April 25, 1976: Ray Meyers W6MLZ #94 columnist for the Los Angeles Herald Examiner, "Ham-on-Air" was our honored guest and featured speaker. Jim WB6OJN has his antenna back in operation and will again be our net control on Tuesdays 1800Z and will try CW on 28.120Mhz. Joanne WA6QKC and OM Duncan K6LHA founders of the 10-10 Net were also honored guests. Their original certificates were issued without 10-10 numbers. It was unanimously resolved that our Gen. Mgr W6LRY issue low 10-10 numbers to WA6QKC and K6LHA.

June 17, 1976: Extra-ordinary meeting at K6CQN's QTH-Hans WB6YYI presented the compilation of the ballots received in response to the Spring 1976 questionnaire for discussion. The Bylaws Revision Committee was appointed to study the returns and make appropriate recommendations. Mary WA6MOF is to assess the impact of deleting "of Southern Calif" from the name of our organization. Hans WB6YYI suggested that a humanitarian award be created and issued to Bob Holmes WA6NOP #5771 for his devoted service to Jim Elder WA6NOG #5842 (now a SK) during Jim's disabling hospitalization.

August 1, 1976: Unanimous approval to issue the first Humanitarian Award to Bob WA6NOP. Please notify the president of worthy candidates to receive this special award. More discussion on the results of the questionnaire. The Bylaws Revision Committee requires more time for further study prior to making recommendations for implementation. Vote was in favor of changing the name to "10-10 Int. Net, Inc." Nominating Committee was appointed-WA6MOF, K5MRU, WB6YYI, WAØYNQ. Elections to be held at the Quarterly Meeting Oct. 17, 1976 and installation of officers in January 1977.

Prospective Members: On 10 meters, contact 10 present members (DX-5), logging Date, Time, Call, Ten-Ten number, Handle, City, State(DX-country). Send this list to your District or DX Manager along with \$2 for dues and \$1 for a Roster. You will receive a Certificate and will be assigned a Ten-Ten number that belongs to you personally for life.

How To Operate 10-10, Exchange Numbers and Get Awards: First become a member and use your Roster. Log all 10-10 contacts as noted above. Circle the Call in your Roster. This will avoid duplicates. Keep a running account of the total 10-10 numbers at the top of each log sheet. When you have a total of 100 (including the first 10 allowed for membership) immediately apply for your first Bar Award. You should check mark the 10-10 numbers in your complete roster to avoid repeat reporting. We allow the 10 initial contacts but all others counted shall be bona-fide NUMBER EXCHANGES as in a "full friendship handshake." List all information as required for membership (do not send log books). Send your list to our Awards Manager Frank Orcutt W4JO 2752 S.W. 3rd St Miami, Fla 33135. Identify your call and 10-10 number, and state the Bar you are requesting each time. There are Bars for each 100. There are special Plaques for 1000, 2500, and 5000. QSL cards are only required for WAS 10-10. **IMPORTANT:** Send in each 100 immediately (no extras and never less than 100). Forget about those early uncounted "one-way" contacts as our Awards are for Bona Fide Number Exchanges; one point only allowed for each number exchanged.

Ten-Ten Chapters: More than 100 Nets throughout the World are now in operation and have weekly on-the-air meetings. Many Chapter Nets issue unique certificates which you may earn by participation in their activities. Many of these have serial numbers and are self propagating, so that you can start your own activities. If you wish to organize a local chapter, please drop a line to our Net Coordinator George Elliott W6ENC.

Renewals: To renew your membership, send \$2 with your old Membership Card to your U.S. District or DX Manager. We must have your call letters, 10-10 Number and date of expiration. If your dues are more than six months in arrears you can be reinstated for the \$1 fee(for a Roster in return). Add \$2 (total \$3) for a full years dues. Your District or DX Manager has Rosters available (\$1) and 10-X Stamps (100 for \$1) so state what any extra money is for. Make all checks payable to: "10-10 Net, Inc."

BAND CONDITIONS: Fabulous! We are snowed with requests for Bar Awards Some report, "Just like old times". We had a Northpole Aurora May 3 with a peak G_a of 56, preceded by 37 and followed by 20. This makes four polarcap auroras this year. During the years 1645 to 1715 not one single aurora was observed. During this 70 year period sunspots were not observed, though many were seen before & after this period

SOLAR ROTATION: A new paper discussing the 27-day period of Sunspot reappearance on the surface of the sun should prove provocative. We hope this does not disappoint our faithful sun worshippers.

27-DAY SOLAR CALENDAR: Presented as an experimental chart for study throughout the year. We plan to update this sometime in 1977. Our plan is to plot only the geomagnetic activity and resulting auroras Suggest you use different color pencils to plot "good days", other valuable information, so we can compare notes later.

RECOMMENDED READING: Chris, WB5IHC, VR-133, suggests we get a copy of "The Jupiter Effect" for good reading. This book's main interest earthquakes and their triggers, such as how solar flares and cosmic rays affect earth spin. A reason for the 11 year cycle. The 1982 peak approaching, as related to a peak that occurred 179 years ago. This is a paperback, published by Vintage. Authors are J.R. Gribbin and S.H. Flaggeman, both Astro Physicists.

BAND CONDITIONS: For the past 45 days have been fabulous! We have processed 165 bar awards, rejected 10, and have 43 applications too "slow" to process in these busy times. This is the greatest activity in the history of the 10/X Net and with no apparent help from Old Sol and only a slight hint of let up. Look for good conditions to pre-vale in the month of July, especially the last two weeks, for sure.

COSMIC RAY RADIATION: A new paper discussing Cosmic-rays from outer space with their possible effects on propagation. This may prove especially interesting during this period of the quiet sun.

1975 SOLAR CALENDAR: Hind-sight is always better than fore-sight!! This is designed to show the dates of 4 auroras (A) with geomagnetic activity index over 40, plus lesser values (o), plus values at least 20 or over (•). We hope you will plot your own good operating days.

WEATHER RADIO: Realistic FM miniature solid-state weather rec'ver uses 9 transistors, 4 diodes, tunes 162.55 to 162.40 mHz, operates from mini-9v battery. 24-hr WX at your fингure tip. Radio Shack 181



PROPAGATION REPORT: Solar Flux and Geomagnetic levels were too low to be of much interest for study so have been deleted this month. A good show is predicted for Aug 7-8 weekend contest. Our propagation reports come by mail weekly, and by radio hourly at the 14 minutes, after each hour from WWV, Boulder Colorado. This service will be completely eliminated by the U. S. Govt after October 1st 1976. It has been under long debate for lack of funds, and lack of use. We may still save it. 





DOWN UNDER CHAPTER (Chapter Head: George - ZL1ARO, 10-X #774)




CHIEF SEATTLE CHAPTER: (Chapter Head: Carl-W7HUL, 10-X #6857)
