ARRL NATIONAL CONVENTION IN DENVER A 10-X SUCCESS: The Colorado Ten-Ten Chapter hosted the 10-X portion of activities at the Denver Convention and have reported that 10-X'rs numbered ten percent of the total attendence. A booth set up in the main lobby of the Denver Hilton served as 10-X Information Center manned by Rich-WBØFQD (Chapter Head). The Saturday morning 10-X Forum was well attended and featured 10-X President; Morrie-W6EHM, with a rundown of results of the recent 10-X poll in the Spring Quarterly Bulletin and remarks as to the importance of renewing memberships each year. 10-X Vice President; Grace-K5MRU, reviewed the history of

10-X. Zero-Land Manager; Rollie-WØLST, praised 10-X activity in Colorado and answered questions from the audience. 10-X Chapter News Editor; Chuck-WAGYNQ. reviewed the importance of reporting chapter activities to 10-X Net Co-Ordinator; George-W6ENC so they can be published in the News and Quarterly Bulletins. Chapter Head; Rich-WBØFQD, presided over the forum as M.C. and, was delighted to see in attendance: Chapter Heads from the Houston (SHOT), the Georgia (NEW SOUTH) the San Antonio (BLUEBONNET), the Illinois (LAND-OF-LINCOLN), the Kansas City (MO-KANTENNERS), and the Tulsa (GREEN COUNTRY) Chapters. Also attending were the Certificate Managers of the Dallas (LONE STAR), & the Florida (ORANGE JUICE) Chapters.

NCØARL BUSY AND SUCCESSFUL: Using an inverted "V" antenna twenty feet above the roof of the Denver, Hilton, the ten meter portion of NCØARL operated from the 21st floor in the hospitality room of the Colorado Ten-Ten Chapter. The station worked 536 contacts (35 states & 5 Canadian Providences) passing out the specially awarded 10-X number;  $1776/\emptyset$ . In addition, other award numbers had been awarded to the station (as reported in the July News) including CENTENNIAL-1776, CATT-1776, and

SKY BLUE WATERS-76. On the morning of the first day, Houston (SHOT) Chapter Head: Bob-WB5FII hand carried to the 10-X Booth a Shot Award & Hot-Shot indorsement-1976. This was followed by other certificate numbers awarded by Charter Heads & Certificate Managers in attendence. They were; NEW SOUTH-1776, LONE STAR-1776, TEXSAN-1776, BLUEBONNET-1776, LAND OF LINCOLN-1776, OJ-1776, GREEN COUNTRY-1776, VIKING-1776 & PAUL BUN-YON-1776. This made a grand total of fourteen much sought after certificate numbers. When the band was in full swing many pile-ups occured. Ten meters opened each day about 0800 hours MDT and continued until 2230 hours. NCØARL had to QRT for thirty minutes during the OSCAR demonstration in Denver's Civic Center to prevent QRM to the very sensitive ten meter receiver being used to hear signals from OSCAR. it was lucky that during this time the ten meter band had taken a temporary closing, but not for long...soon it opened NCØARL with Chuck-WAØYNQ back up and once again loud clear signals could be heard.








TAMALE CHAPTER: (Chapter Head, Phyllis-W5MRP 10-X 1475)

This chapter, just forming, is in the West Palm Beach area in Florida with plans for a net and certificate.



















CHIEF SEATTLE CHAPTER: (Chapter Head, Carl-10-X 6857)
